Dear Ones,



We celebrated Christmas with our children in shifts, concluding on Christmas Day with a right proper meal of slow roasted pork, sweet potatoes, collard greens, and an apple walnut cake from the kitchen of Joyce Pate. How about the life of our community and hundreds, thousands, beyond it, touched in some way by our church's life? What a void there would be in the world!

Though our time with you has been brief, we have been blessed beyond words by First Presbyterian.
