Chris has worked all summer preparing all the anthems for the rest of 2022 and recording a "Chris-in-a-Box" CD for each voice part for all the anthems they will be singing! Everyone will be able to learn their voice parts by listening to his instructions on the recording even if they cannot read music! A take-home packet of these anthems will be given to each member so that they will be able to study the music at home without taking their choir folder away from the church.

In addition to the weekly Sunday anthems, each singer will receive all the special Christmas music that they will be presenting on the night of December 11th for "The Music of Christmas" service. Chris has again prepared CD recordings of all the voice parts, a recording of the anthems performed by professional groups, and a packet of music of these anthems so that they will be able to practice reading the music at home.

Children's Choir to Resume on Sunday, September 11th!

This season the children will resume their weekly Sunday morning choir rehearsals on September 11th. They will be preparing their first anthem to be sung on September 25th, as well as their Christmas musical, "Beneath a Shining Star" to be performed for the congregation on December 4th.

Chris has recorded a CD for their September 25th anthem – "Feed My Lambs" for the children to take home, play, and sing along with their families. Copies of the anthem will be given to each child to take home and study.

"Beneath a Shining Star" tells the story of a group of Sunday School children during their final days of rehearsal for their upcoming Christmas program. There is a bossy director, a band of sassy angels, a greedy innkeeper and his sidekick, and a host of other delightful characters. Every child will be a star with something to say and do. All the children will receive a CD of the musical and a script to take home and listen in order to learn their songs and lines.

All children in pre-school to the sixth grade are encouraged to participate in choir every Sunday morning at 9:00-9:30 a.m.

Chris specializes in teaching both adults and children (who are able to read) to play the piano, and to learn to sing properly and easily. He will be here at the church on Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays depending on the number of new students who wish to receive lessons. The cost of each weekly lesson is \$35 for a 40-minute lesson, and \$45 for an hour session each week.
