


Writers, please include the following in your devotional (about 350 words):

FROM THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE

Candidates to be considered for nominations for church officers.

It is time to start considering nominations for the 2027 class of the Session and the Diaconate.

Elders and Deacons must be active members of First Presbyterian Church for at least one year, may or may not have served previously on the Session or Diaconate, must be of good character, have strong faith, love Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, and must be elected by the congregation. Officers may be elected to consecutive terms if their total continuous service does not exceed six years. If possible, please check with your nominees to be sure they are willing and able to serve. Every member may make single or multiple nominations. Self-nominations are encouraged. Names of candidates may be submitted by completing the form in the bulletin and placing it in the offering plate, giving the form to Teresa Smith or Emily Byrd, co-chairs of the Nominating Committee, or leaving the form at the Church Office. Acceptance of candidates will close via these forms on September 22.

Recommendations will be consolidated and considered by the Nominating Committee. The names will be presented for election at a Congregational Meeting on October 6. There will be an opportunity for nominations from the floor at the Congregational Meeting in accordance with the Book of Order.
